Annual meeting board report

Noontide's trustees have been listening for our Father-Mother's voice to shepherd us in many ways this year. Noontide is a vessel filled up so full with blessings, it's running over! The most recent blessings are our new employees.

Last December we had lovely proof that supply and demand coexist in God's plan. Our longtime business manager had to step away from her position. We weren't surprised when we quickly found someone who had served on our board in the past, was very qualified for the job, and a perfect fit—our **new business manager, Michelle Irish!**

Michelle and her husband live in Owosso and are members of the Greater Lansing Church. When serving as one of our Noontide trustees, Michelle chaired a board project, where prayer led her to pick two citations as standards of measurement for our Board of Trustees yearly self-assessment.

The first standard is from *The Manual of the Mother Church* by Mary Baker Eddy: "Christian Science Nurse. Sect. 31. A member of The Mother Church who represents himself or herself as a Christian Science nurse shall be one who has a demonstrable knowledge of Christian Science practice, who thoroughly understands the practical wisdom necessary in a sick room, and who can take proper care of the sick." (*Man*, 49:7)

The second standard chosen for our assessment is from the Christian Science textbook: "The nurse should be cheerful, orderly, punctual, patient, full of faith, receptive to Truth and Love." (*Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures*, Mary Baker Eddy, 395:18). Our board continues to discover how rich these two standards are in meaning and application.

“I will listen for Thy voice”*

Some notes from a talk given by **Janet Horton, Col. (Ret.)**, our Annual Meeting keynote speaker. And what a keynote she gave us—“Come to a position of attention!! Listen up!!” Thus began her riveting talk.

“**A**fter 28 years in the military one thing you really know is **coming to a position of attention!** In a spiritual sense, it afforded me many insights into the meaning of a line from my favorite childhood Hymn, ‘Shepherd Show Me How To Go,’— *I will listen for Thy voice.*”*

Horton explained the importance and value of the military discipline of coming to a position of attention. She related an experience she had while investigating the charge of sexual harassment by a Marine, and his threat to kill Horton.

He was an enlisted man, and she was a commissioned officer. One day he barged into the chapel annex in an enraged state of mind, poking her in the chest so hard he propelled her backwards. Seeking spiritual guidance, the thought came to Horton, “Bring him to a position of attention.” She did so, and was struck by how powerful a discipline it was for him. Disregarding what else was going on in his world, the moment he was ordered, “Marine, come to a position of attention,” he came to attention, and yielded to that supreme command.

Horton continued that Mary Baker Eddy states emphatically we can experience the “scientific man and his Maker...if [we] would subordinate the fleshly perceptions to the spiritual sense and source of being” (*Unity of Good*, Mary Baker Eddy, 46).

She indicated that obedience to God’s law of harmony enables man to say to the material body, corporeal sense, or anything that would be insubordinate to Spirit’s absolute dominion and unopposed spiritual power, “I don’t have to listen to your voice, your lying arguments! You can’t intimidate me, impress me, or command obedience from me. The carnal mind must be put off by obeying only the voice of divine Mind.”

Our textbook says: “The immortal divine Mind takes away all its supposed sovereignty, and saves mortal mind from itself” (*SH*, 152). Thus, the only way the mortal

is dropped for the immortal is for Truth to rebuke error. Only Truth can save mortal mind from itself, its own sense of self will, or the carnal mind.

Horton’s experience showed the Christ of Christian Science is a full-service Savior who saves all from sin, disease and death. The voice of pure Truth guides, directs, and saves as no other voice can. “Listening for Thy voice” is intimately connected with measuring the validity of any voice presenting itself to our consciousness, against the all-important correct definition and understanding of God.

A final thought from Horton’s talk: We’re not just praying to acknowledge this proper order of government only for ourselves, but for all those whom we see. By listening only to “Thy voice” we get the concept of God and man right. The order of perfection is expressed and the fruits are significant!

Financial report

The annual independent CPA examination of our books shows that our accounts are in order. Here's a snapshot of our financial position:

Considering the market conditions, we can be grateful our portfolio is down only about 1½ to 2%. This is a result of our conservative investments, which are holding steady. This is after we had to draw \$75,000 dollars from our investments this year to cover current expenses. In 2022 our operating expenses exceeded contributions by \$73,000.

We very much appreciate the donations that make Noontide a viable Christian Science nursing resource. A very special thanks to the Farmington Church for their generous donation of seventeen thousand dollars. We deeply appreciate contributions from individuals, an extremely important portion—25 to 30% of our budget.
